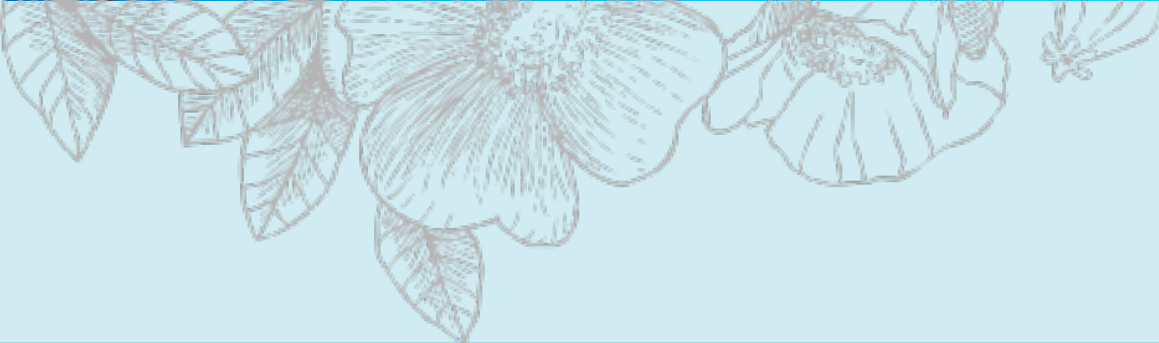

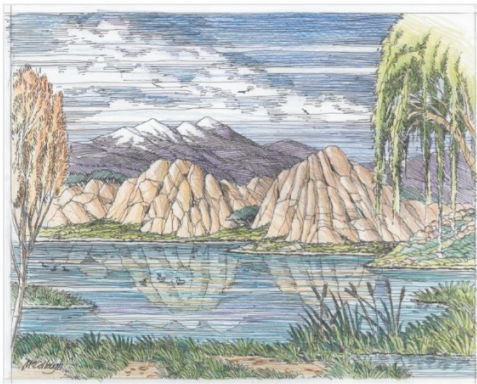
On-going ministries: We are grateful for the volunteers of our church family who
