"Meet the Pastor" Luncheon at Las Fuentes



From Pastor Jay

I am excited that we are going to try to do a Wednesday night program (5:30-7:30pm), beginning September 16th and continuing each Wednesday night for 10 weeks. I have seen this be very successful in the past, and it is happening in churches all over the country in the present. The components are usually the same: a shared meal, a time for Bible learning, and a time for fun. Think of it as intergenerational vacation Bible school or a one-room schoolhouse. Why do we need to do this? If we desire to have children in the church, then we need to provide programs and entry points for youth other than Sunday morning. Adults enjoy it as well. It is another way to experience shared meals, fellowship, learning and fun. It becomes a mid-week oasis from the regular routine. And a chance to not stress about what's for dinner! So, give it a try. I have also seen people not currently attending church find this to be their entry point to the congregation, so invite others to join us. Our thanks to Tawnya Worthington for being willing to serve as a co-coordinator for this ministry. Linda Foote has agreed to help out as well. We need all of you to help out in some way. More to come...

We are quietly working on the beginnings of an environmental ministry in the church. It will be our focus on Wednesday night, September 30th during our Wednesday night program. We had an initial meeting about a week ago where our own Chuck Budinger led us in a discussion of local water concerns. Peter Pierson of Prescott Creeks was also at the meeting. I have recently met with Grace Burford of Prescott College. She was formerly the religious studies professor and is now shifting to a role as the college chaplain. We talked about how she might help bring some students to the

meeting on the 30th. And in talking with Peter and Chuck, our hope is to have a "hands-on" service project ready a week or two after the meeting to allow the students to participate – Prescott Creeks will help us with that. My vision is that we eventually broaden our tent through the interfaith group and become a large "caring for creation" group in the city. We shall see where it all goes, but at least we are trying to respond to our mandate to "exercise dominion over the earth" (care and responsibility). We will also look at our church practices as well — moving away from plastics, etc. If environmental ministry and environmental justice are of interest to you, please plan to join this task group.

I also met this week with Christine Mack, public relations liaison with Habitat for Humanity. She told me of our long history of support and partnering with Habitat. I think our own Joanne Lussier was in on the initial founding of our local chapter. North of 70 homes have been built in our area through the years, and there are plans for many more in coming years. All sorts of volunteer opportunities are available in addition to helping in the building process. I would like to see us get more personally involved with Habitat, so if this is an interest of yours, please let me know.

We will have a booth at the new student orientation event at Embry Riddle Aeronautical University on Thursday, August 20, from 1:00-3:00 p.m. This is a chance to introduce our church to the first year parents and students. If you have a connection with the school or an interest in helping us out that day, please let me know.

The ceiling in Perkins Hall is being secured and painted this week. It may take another week or two to finish, so please be careful as you spend time in the room. The finished panels look quite bright and fresh. Not to mention safe and secure! Thanks to the trustees for getting this done in August.

I continue to listen and learn as your new pastor. I am grateful for the gifts and talents of our staff and members. We are blessed in so many ways. Our friendliness during the passing of the peace and at our coffee time in Perkins Hall after worship are signs of a healthy church.
