

It doesn't sound right to say I am enjoying researching the seven deadly sins — researching, not practicing! There is so much on the internet to explore. I discovered Rodin had a particular interest in depicting lust. This Sunday is Valentine's Day and an appropriate day to compare love and lust. Lust gets a bad rap in some ways, so we want to explore why that is, and also look at the ways it turns deadly.

It might seem hard to believe, but a handful of TV shows have been linked to the seven deadly sins. My beloved Gilligan's Island!

Ginger represents LUST - she wears skimpy outfits, is obsessed with her looks, and is a borderline nymphomaniac.

Mary Ann represents ENVY - she is jealous of Ginger's beauty.

- The Sunday morning class "Living The Questions" started again at 9:00 am. The topic will be "Evil and Suffering" next Sunday.


