Several people asked for a copy of the autobiography I quoted in the worship service last week. It is by Portia Nelson. The following details are taken from Wikipedia:

Nelson was a cancer survivor, having conquered breast cancer after a mastectomy in 1973. [9] Four years later, Popular Library published Nelson's milestone book, There's a Hole in My Sidewalk: The Romance of Self-Discovery. (Beyond Words Publishing reissued it in 1993.) Its cover appears on a poster displayed in the office

of Sean McGuire, the fictional psychologist portrayed by $\underline{\text{Robin Williams}}$ in the film $\underline{\text{Good Will}}$ Hunting (1997). Nelson turned the book into an off-Broadway musical, presented at the York Theatre in Manhattan. One of her poems, "Autobiography in Five Short Chapters", went on to become a highly popular self-help and recovery text:

Chapter I

I walk down the street.

There is a deep hole in the sidewalk.

I fall in.

I am lost ... I am helpless.

It isn't my fault.

It takes me forever to find a way out.

I walk down the same street.

There is a deep hole in the sidewalk.

I pretend I don't see it.

I fall in again.

I can't believe I am in the same place.

But it isn't my fault.

It still takes a long time to get out.

I walk down the same street. There is a deep hole in the sidewalk.

I see it is there.

I still fall in ... it's a habit.

My eyes are open.

I know where I am.

It is my fault.

I get out immediately.

Chapter IV

I walk down the same street.

There is a deep hole in the sidewalk.

I walk around it.

Chapter V

I walk down another street.

The poem (which was often uncredited to Nelson) was adopted by motivational speakers and reprinted in *The Tibetan Book of Living* and Dying by Sogyal Rinpoche,[10] as well as in the foreword of TV actress Roseanne Barr's autobiography, My Lives. $^{\text{\tiny{[1]}}}$ Jazz singer $^{\text{\tiny{Dianne}}}$ Reeves set the poem to music and recorded it as "The First Five Chapters" on her live CD $\underline{\textit{In}}$ the Moment (2000).

We extend special thanks to these volunteers for donating their time during the hectic week before Christmas. Our next designated packing week is February 3-7, 2020.






