TREASURER REPORT

Income as of June 30 is \$79,570. Total expenses are \$70,512. Net income is \$9,058.

Year-to-date income is at 65% of the income budget of \$122,450. Year-to-date expenses are at 48% of the expense budget of \$146,905.

In addition to the regular financial support from our congregational members and friends, we have received \$5,000 from the Southwest Conference UCC in grant funding for videography and other expenses for providing "hybrid worship services," both online and in person.
