I know what you are thinking. I have as much doubt about these words as you do. I can come up with all kinds of arguments for why they do not ring true, and I certainly, like you, can give all kinds of personal examples of how they have failed me. And yet, there does seem to be plenty of disciples of their truth across a broad spectrum: sales experts, spiritualists, metaphysicalists, and success gurus. I love the simple truth my sales manager used to tell us all the time: "Ask for the sale! What are the possible outcomes? Yes, no, or maybe so. But you know what? When you ask, the odds of a yes go up!" Indeed!

The reason I bring all this up is to let you know I pray daily for God to bring people to our church: nudge them, plant a seed of motivation in them, direct them, all the mysterious ways God works on all of us. And the strange (or not so strange) result is people come. We have received two calls at the office in recent weeks inquiring about our church and expressing an interest in coming. Our "open and affirming" stance is the reason behind the interest. Another came because of the beauty of our building. That probably happens more than we know. I think others come because I asked God to send them! So, I invite you to join me in the prayer. It goes something like this: "Loving God, there are people out there who need this church. They will find this to be home for whatever the reasons. Tug at their hearts and plant a thought in their minds to visit us. And help us to extend an extravagant welcome!"

Moderator's Message

Chancel Renovation Proposed

When we come together to worship God, our visual focus is to the front of our church. What we see in the chancel shapes our experience.

Over the years the look of our chancel has changed several times. Some of the changes have been long standing (the placement of the choir pews), some have been temporary (placement of banners and the dressing on the communion table) and some permanent (the Rose Window).

Each of these changes have been brought on by the changing needs of our congregation and the ways we do worship.

Our current needs are for more flexible space that allows for a diversity of musical presentations that enhance worship. The challenges we face are the varying size of our choir, the placement of the instruments, and the focal point of the communion table.

A Chancel Renovation group has been commissioned with proposing an option to address our current and future needs. It is recommended that the choir pews be removed. We would replace them with chairs designed for choirs. This will allow us to arrange the chairs, instruments and communion table as needed. It will also allow us to adjust the number of chairs to the size of the choir for each Sunday.

I feel that this proposal is appropriate to our needs and will sustain the aesthetic of our sanctuary and enrich worship. I'm open to your comments and suggestions.
