#### **June Missions**

#### The Mission Committee focus for this month:

- (1) Strengthen The Church is a special mission offering to reimagine and build the future of the UCC. Shared at the conference and national levels, STC largely supports youth ministries and full-time leaders for new churches in parts of the country where the UCC voice has not been heard. As God calls our congregations to be the "church" in new ways, your generosity will plant new churches, awaken new ideas in existing churches and develop the spiritual life in our youth and young adults. STC funds will also be used to award grants to help congregations communicate the "God is still speaking" message.
- (2) Donations are requested for children's school supplies to be shipped to impoverished villages and refugee camps around the globe. A donation box is located in the sanctuary with a list of needed supplies. The Outreach Committee will purchase the bags needed, stuff those bags with the needed supplies, and ship them to the site designated by the Church World Service.

#### **Church World Service school kits:**

CWS School Kit Supplies needed:

- 1. One pair of blunt scissors removed from the package (rounded tip, only)
- 2. Three 70-count bound notebooks or notebooks totaling 200-210 pages (No loose-leaf or filler paper.)
- 3. One 30-centimeter 12" ruler
- 4. One hand-held pencil sharpener removed from the package
- 5. One large eraser (no pencil cap erasers)
- 6. Six new, unsharpened pencils with erasers removed from the package
- 7. One box of 24 crayons (only 24)
