Looking ahead, we face the same headwinds that all churches are dealing with – an uncertain COVID and flu winter; the costs of most everything rising from inflation; a predicted economic downturn as the Fed works on reducing inflation; and around fifty percent less worship attendance after COVID re-opening.

The good news for our church includes having no debt and a church Foundation to help, if needed. Some other positive items for us include a large number of new members and attendees post-COVID lockdown, almost making us a new congregation in many ways, and more children attending than we have had in a long time. We made tough decisions at the start of COVID to significantly reduce our budget and return to a volunteer

operating model. It has served us well through the last two years. As stewards of our building, we have the opportunity to host recovery groups once again or offer a non-profit organization space in our basement. We need your estimates of giving for 2023 to help us decide what is possible. Thank you for your support during 2022! Pastor Jay

Treasurer's Report on financial activity as of November 30, 2022


Income vs Expense:

CHRISTMAS 1895

This photograph taken in 1895 is of a Christmas program presented by the young Chinese men from the school organized by Rev. McLean and T. W. Otis to teach the Chinese residents the English language.

We can also date the photo to 1895 since the baptismal font that was dedicated to Rev. Stephen Dubois Demarest was not delivered until just after the school was established. The kerosene lamps are still in place and the Women's Fellowship replaced them in 1896 with electric lamps. It is Christmas time and the greens are hung and they include a Star of David. The church pews that are still in use around our church are in the photo also.
