Given that the status quo is so potent, how can we change ourselves and our organizations?" (Robert Kegan and Lisa Lahey). 


Financial activity, year-to-date as of November 30, 2023

Your church also has needs and right now those needs are financial. We are in unprecedented times. How do we create a church budget for 2024with so many unknowns? How do you decide what to give to this church for 2024? These questions have no immediate answers, so our church budget and your offer of financial giving are not set in stone. They are estimates. Your estimate of giving for 2024 will help us begin to understand what might be possible for the next year. So, with a thankful heart full of hope we are asking you to help us right now, to get through our 144th year here in Prescott.
