

She is not given a name. Nicodemus got one in John 3. That is not the only misogyny in the story. She is judged wrongly by all the old preachers - including me from my sermon notes I found from 1989! Thanks to feminist theologians, she has been rescued from labels like whore and prostitute. Come Sunday to find out who she really was. And come Sunday to find out why this story speaks so powerfully to our current situation in America. Jesus had to go to Samaria to offer inclusive love to a marginalized and excluded woman. So many in our day are working to narrow who is acceptable and bury our racial history behind white supremacy. We will choose to follow the way of Jesus!

Please join us to become certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the use of
an automated external defibrillator (AED). The training will be led by New Life CPR. This is
useful training for all and especially since the church now has an AED on site, it would be great
to have trained users in the congregation. The Heartsaver CPR AED course trains participants
to give CPR, and use an AED in a safe, timely, and effective manner. Reflects science and
education from the American Heart Association Guidelines Update for CPR and Emergency
Cardiovascular Care (ECC).

The training will be held in Perkins Hall after the church service on Sunday, April 16th, and it should last approximately 2.5 hours. The church will cover the cost of the training and also provide pizza to trainees.


