

# Wonderful 'Thank YOU'



## ADULT EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES COMING UP!

Here is a schedule of events and discussions folks have expressed interest in. I am really looking forward to these and more!

December 3, 17, and 31, Mondays noon-1, "Personal

Spiritual Journeys: listening and sharing" Ongoing as participants wish. Here are a few questions for reflection to get us started. Add more as you wish. We will meet in the **church library**, downstairs.

- 1. In a few words or phrases, describe how you are presently doing.
- 2. How have you experienced God lately?
- 3. What has been life-giving? What has been life-draining?
- 4. What things are presently occupying your mind and heart?

**December 9 and 23 and ongoing as we wish: Sundays, 1:00,** "Social Justice: past, present, and future for the UCC and beyond." What does social justice mean for us? What were the Social Gospel and Liberation Theology and how have those movements shaped our understanding of social justice? What actions can each of us take, can the church take to shape justice in our communities?

"Reading the Parables: Many interpretations, No easy answers." A discussion group. Dates and times to be announced, starting early in 2019.

"Homosexuality and the Bible (and the UCC): what do the scriptures really say?" Either a one-day seminar or a series of presentations. February, 2019

"Women in the Bible: a women's retreat" Spring, 2019. Powerful women, unnamed women, "bad girls," suffering women, joyful women. We will look at the texts and play around with alternative versions. The library has many good books on theology through a woman's eyes and experiences.

Look over the books under the Christian Education bulletin board for possible topics for small group discussions or for seminars. These books plus many resources in our library will inspire us to take on new and unexpected opportunities. # MISSIONS OUTREACH FOR DECEMBER

Our December mission emphasis includes;

- Our denomination's Christmas Fund which supports low income clergy and their spouses, and
- IND OUTREACH
- 2. Our DACA Assistance Fund, which helps college age DACA students meet the expenses of paying out-of-state tuition and the expense of applying for the renewal of their DACA status. Presently, our DACA Fund is supporting Franceny, who was a part of our panel of students at our March DACA presentation in Perkins Hall. Franceny needs \$5000 to meet the out-of-state tuition for her last semester at Yavapai Community College. The last Sunday date for being able to help Franceny meet her goal is Sunday, December 23rd. Franceny was brought to the United States when she was only 4 years old. Through high school and college, she has maintained mostly "A's" while taking Honor Classes.
